- Those Scouts whose parents are willing to sign a liability release form and will be present during flight time may get the chance to fly in a 2 man or 4 man aircraft, **weather permitting.**

Due to the cost of liability insurance the flight portion of the event is not endorsed by Girl Scouts. Parents must understand this and be willing to take full responsibility for their daughter during flight time.

Cost: \$25.00/Scout due at time of registration

Participants must be registered Scouts 11 to 18 years old.

Troops are welcome to come Friday evening between 5:30 PM and 7 PM pitch tents and stay the night.

Troops will be responsible for their own tents, Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast and IP/Merit Badge.

Friday Ground School, evening snack, Saturday mid morning snack, lunch and a fun patch are included in the price. Parents and troop leaders wishing to fly will be given a chance once every Scout has flown, **time permitting.** Everyone flying must submit a signed Majors Flying Club release form and scouts must submit a Young Eagles form signed by their parents at time of registration. Registration is first come first serve with those who have never flown small aircraft accepted before those who have flown before.

Maximum capacity: 50 Scouts

Registration deadline is Sept. 2nd no late registration accepted.
